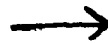

Using an FTP Client

1. Connect to FTP Host ia341014.us.archive.org
2. Use your Archive username, rlaughton@sympatico.ca, and password to connect to the server. You should see a subdirectory named "CEF_CM5_1915" (if you don't see this subdirectory, you may have logged into the wrong server!).
3. Put your files into this directory. (You may also delete or replace files).
4. When you are finished uploading your files, **check your item in** by clicking on this link.

revised notes wording

The Nominal Rolls of the Canadian Expeditionary Force are described by Library and Archives Canada as the "lists of soldiers on strength with the unit on a particular date. They were generally created in the course of a unit's formation in Canada, often in preparation for departure overseas. Five copies of nominal rolls (army form MFW 20) were to be prepared by the regimental adjutant. Two were submitted to the headquarters of the Military District in which the unit was raised (one of which was to be forwarded to the Department of Militia and Defence in Ottawa). Three were to accompany the unit overseas. The first page was to contain a list of officers, arranged in order of rank. Other ranks followed on succeeding pages, arranged in alphabetical order, showing full name, rank, and regimental number.

The 5th Canadian Mounted Rifles from Sherbrooke Quebec served in France and Flanders with the 2nd Mounted Rifle Brigade from September 21, 1915 to January 1, 1916. It was then reorganized to the 5th Canadian Mounted Rifle Battalion and served with the 8th Infantry Brigade of the 3rd Canadian Division. until armistice.
